II. Background and Purpose

UbiBrowser is an open database of protein ubiquitination interactions. To protect the intellectual work of the Provider and ensure reasonable use of the data, the User must agree to and comply with this Agreement for bulk data downloads.

III. Scope of Data Use and Restrictions

1. Permitted Uses:

- The User may use bulk downloaded data for non-commercial scientific research, teaching, or internal academic analysis.
- The User must cite UbiBrowser-related publications when publishing results, in accordance with Section IV.

2. Prohibited Uses:

- Without explicit written permission from the Provider, the User may not sell, transfer, rent, or share the bulk data (or any subset or derivative) with third-party individuals, organizations, or public platforms in its original file format, tables, or API export files.
- The User may not use bulk data for any commercial purposes, including but not

limited to embedding in commercial databases, training commercial software, or as a source for commercial services.

- The User may not substantively modify the data and claim it as an independently constructed dataset for public release.

IV. Citation Obligations

The User must properly cite the original UbiBrowser publications in any public outputs (including papers, conference abstracts, theses, preprints, reports, etc.) based on the bulk data. The recommended citation format is as follows (please cite the latest version of UbiBrowser):

Failure to cite appropriately may result in termination of data access rights and a public statement of violation by the Provider.

V. Data Delivery and Signature Process

1. The User shall apply for bulk data download using the contact information at the end of this Agreement.
2. The User shall print this Agreement, complete it fully, and sign it by hand (for institutional users, a seal or signature from the principal investigator is required).
3. The User shall scan or photograph the signed Agreement (clearly legible) and send it via email to the Provider's designated address.
4. Upon receipt of the signed agreement, the Provider shall review it as soon as possible and respond with a download link or transmission method for the bulk data.
5. Upon downloading, the User is deemed to have accepted all terms of this Agreement.

VI. Data Ownership and Termination

- All copyright and ownership of bulk data remain with the UbiBrowser Team and contributors. This Agreement does not transfer any ownership rights.
 - If the User violates Section III or IV, the Provider may immediately terminate access, require the User to delete all downloaded data, and reserve the right to pursue legal actions.
